WITHDRAWAL OF STAFF MOTION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and states as follows:

- 1. On March 25, 2011, the Staff filed a Motion to Cancel the certificate of service authority granted on November 12, 2004, to Titan Communications, L.L.C.. ("the Company"), because it reported no Missouri jurisdictional revenue for the past two years. Staff's motivation for its filing was not to be punitive, but to merely remove those telecommunications companies not actively involved in providing services in Missouri to better maintain the Commission's records.
- 2. On April 26, 2011, the Company filed an Objection to Staff's Motion, in which it explained that the Company needed to retain its certification in order to maintain its status in the Commission case TC-2005-0067. The Staff's Motion, if granted, might jeopardize that status, which the Staff views as an undesirable result.

WHEREFORE, Staff withdraws its Motion to cancel the Certificate of Service Authority of Titan Communications, L.L.C. and asks that this matter be closed without further Commission action.
