ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On July 18, 2012, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Pay Phone Company, Inc.'s ("PPC") certificate to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri be canceled. The Commission granted PPC a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment in File Number TA-91-49.

The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order, excluding weekends and holidays, to file a motion for hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to file an objection or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than July 30, 2012, with:
