ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

Issue Date: August 14, 2015

Effective Date: August 24, 2015

This order cancels the private pay telephone certificate of Herschel's Coin Communications Company.

On July 27, 2015, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Herschel's Coin Co.'s certificate to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri be canceled.

In Case Number PA-2004-0054, the Commission granted Herschel's Coin Co. a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment.

Staff's motion states that the company requested cancellation of its certificate of service authority. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel Herschel's Coin Co.'s certificate of service authority as the company is no longer providing service in Missouri.

On July 29, 2015, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond to Motion allowing anyone to file a response or request a hearing to do so no later than August 10, 2015. No responses were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo 2000, which states, in part, “[a]ny

certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Herschel’s Coin Co.’s request and Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Herschel’s Coin Communications Company shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The private payphone certificate granted to Herschel’s Coin Communications Company, in Case Number PA-2004-0054, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on August 24, 2015.
3. This case may be closed on August 25, 2015.
