ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO REQUEST AND DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION

On January 26, 2022, Global Tel*Link Corporation d/b/a ViaPath Technologies filed a request to cancel the certificate of service authority granted to its subsidiary, Public Communications Services, Inc. (the Company), to provide private payphone services in the State of Missouri. The Company also requested any related tariffs be cancelled. The request states that the Company has no customers in Missouri. The Commission granted the Company a certificate of service authority to provide private payphone services in Case No. TA-2000-788.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed ten days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.

The Staff of the Public Service Commission (Staff) is directed to review the request and file a recommendation regarding the cancellation of the Company's certificate of service authority and any accompanying tariffs.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to file an objection or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than February 7, 2022, with:

2. On or before February 25, 2022, Staff shall file a recommendation regarding the request to cancel the certificate of service authority and any accompanying tariffs of the Company.
