STAFF’S MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves the Missouri Public Service Commission’s (Commission) to allow all parties to file all their rebuttal testimony on all issues by August 30, 2007. As presently ordered, at the Staff’s suggestion, rebuttal testimony on all issues except class cost of service and rate design is due by August 23, 2007, and rebuttal testimony on class cost of service and rate design is due by August 30, 2007. Setting August 30, 2007, as the filing date for all rebuttal testimony on all issues will allow the parties a better opportunity to explore settlement during the settlement conference scheduled the week of August 20, 2007, and will prejudice no party. The Staff has contacted all the parties regarding changing the filing date as aforesaid, and received responses from all but Ford Motor Company, the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers group. No party who responded to the Staff objects to moving the August 23, 2007, filing date.

WHEREFORE, the Staff moves the Commission to modify the procedural schedule in this case to allow all parties to file by August 30, 2007, all their rebuttal testimony on all issues.
