ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION FOR THIRD EXTENSION
OF TIME TO FILE PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On December 13, 2007, Kenneth Jaeger and Blue Lagoon, LLC, filed a joint application. That application requests, among other things, authority from the Commission for Mr. Jaeger to transfer his Ralls County, Missouri, lagoon and sewer system to Blue Lagoon, LLC, to grant Blue Lagoon, LLC, a certificate of convenience and necessity, and to allow Blue Lagoon, LLC, to charge certain rates to its customers.

The Commission convened a prehearing conference on February 4, and required the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than February 11. Due to joint motions from the parties, the Commission later extended that deadline to March 25, and then again to April 15.

On April 15, the Staff of the Commission, on its on behalf and on behalf of the other parties, filed a Joint Motion for Third Extension of Time to File Proposed Procedural Schedule. Staff explains that additional time is needed to investigate the applicants' request, and to ascertain what effect, if any, Mr. Jaeger's pending bankruptcy petition might

have on this case. As a result, the parties ask the Commission to extend the time for filing a proposed procedural schedule until May 15, 2008.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. But because all the parties have joined in the motion, the Commission will waive the ten-day requirement, and will take up the motion unopposed.

The Commission finds the motion reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Joint Motion for Third Extension of Time to File Proposed Procedural Schedule is granted.
2. The parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than May 15, 2008.
3. This order shall become effective on April 16, 2008.
