## ORDER OF IMPLEMENTATION

On December 23, 1992, the Commission issued its Report and Order in Case No. TO-92-306 approving a statewide expanded calling scope plan. The plan, among other provisions, modifies community optional service (COS) to a two-way service only and adjusts the rates for COS. The Commission's Report and Order also directed its Technical Committee to file a report containing a schedule for implementation of the services established under the plan, including the modified COS. The Technical Committee filed its report on April 21, 1993.

The report contained a schedule for implementation of each proposed COS routes which has passed the calling criteria to show a community of interest. The Commission is of the opinion that the report should be considered as Staff's recommendation that these routes be implemented, and based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission determines that the routes listed in Attachment A to this Order should be implemented by the primary toll carrier according to the schedule contained in the Technical Committee's report.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the community optional service routes listed in Attachment A to this Order shall be implemented by the primary toll carrier according to the schedule contained in the April 21, 1993 report of the Commission's Technical Committee.
  - 2. That this Order shall become effective on April 1, 1994.
