ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF CORPORATE NAME

On January 30, 1995, ZTS, Inc. (ZTS) and MVP Communications, Inc. (MVP) submitted a request to the Public Service Commission (Commission) for recognition of a change of corporate name from ZTS Inc. to MVP Communications, Inc. The Commission granted a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications to ZTS in Case No. TA-93-297.

On February 18, 1994, ZTS amended its Articles of Incorporation to reflect a name change to MVP Communications, Inc. Applicant MVP now intends to adopt the tariffs previously filed by ZTS, Inc. and requests that the Commission reflect the change of name from ZTS, Inc. to MVP Communications, Inc., with further authority to file an Adoption Notice.

On March 10, 1995, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation. The Staff stated that it had no objection to Company's change of name. Staff recommended that the Commission approve the name change. The Staff also recommended that the Commission order MVP to file a notice to adopt the tariff previously filed by ZTS, or, alternatively, to file a tariff which reflects the name change.

Having reviewed the joint filing and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that requested change of name, from ZTS to MVP, should be recognized. The Commission further finds that MVP should be ordered to file a tariff reflecting the adoption of the name change as set out above.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the change of corporate name from ZTS, Inc. to MVP Communications, Inc. is hereby recognized.
- 2. That MVP Communications, Inc. is ordered to file tariffs reflecting the approved name change or adoption of tariffs, within 10 days after the effective date of this order.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on March 28, 1995.
