ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF NAME

On August 25, 2000, Global Crossing North American Networks, Inc. (Global Crossing), formerly known as Frontier Communications Inc. (Frontier), filed a letter and a new tariff with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) notifying the Commission of its change of corporate name from Frontier to Global Crossing. The effective date on the tariff was October 5, 2000, and that effective date was extended to October 12, 2000. Global Crossing included with its filing a copy of its Certificate of Amendment issued by the Missouri Secretary of State's office on November 24, 1999. On September 26, 2000, Global Crossing filed its substitute tariff sheets with an effective date of October 12, 2000.

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its recommendation with an attached memorandum on October 2, 2000, stating that Staff had reviewed Global Crossing's request and had no objection to the change of corporate name. Staff stated that Global Crossing has met all of the requirements of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060, and therefore, the Commission should approve the name change as reflected in the proposed tariff sheets.

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The Commission has reviewed the filings and finds that the name change should be recognized and the proposed tariff sheet should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the adopted name "Global Crossing North American Networks, Inc." is acknowledged.

2. That the tariff, filed in Tariff No. 200100217, by Global Crossing North American Networks, Inc., on August 25, 2000, as amended September 26, 2000, is approved to become effective on October 12, 2000. The tariff approved is:

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3. That this order shall become effective on October 12, 2000.

4. That this case may be closed on October 13, 2000.

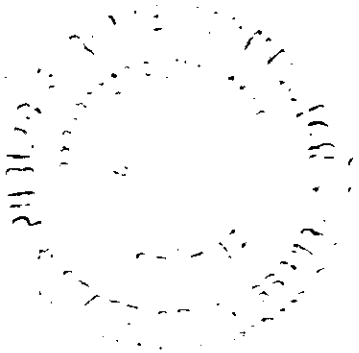
