ORDER SETTING TIME FOR RESPONSE

This order sets the time for responses to the Office of the Public Counsel's motion to suspend Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's tariff.

On April 2, 2002, Southwestern Bell filed a tariff revision (File No. 200200843) with a proposed effective date of May 2, 2002. On April 23, 2002, Public Counsel filed a motion requesting that the Commission suspend the tariff. Southwestern Bell extended the effective date of its tariff to May 6, 2002. Because of the quickly approaching effective date, the Commission will set a time for the filing of responses to Public Counsel's motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That any responses to the Office of the Public Counsel's Motion to Suspend and Request for an Evidentiary Hearing shall be filed no later than April 29, 2002.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 29, 2002.
