ORDER RECOGNIZING NAME CHANGE

On December 19, 2013, CenturyLink notified the Commission that its affiliate Embarq Payphone Services, Inc. was changing its name to CenturyLink Public Communications, Inc. However, CenturyLink sent that notification via e-mail to the Commission's General Counsel rather than to the Secretary of the Commission and the notification was not forwarded to the Commission's Data Center for processing. The Secretary and the Data Center were made aware of the notification on April 7, 2015, and this file was opened at that time.

Embarq Payphone Services, Inc. has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements for changing its name to CenturyLink Public Communications, Inc. The Commission will recognize the name change.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission recognizes the name change of Embarq Payphone Services, Inc. to CenturyLink Public Communications, Inc.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
3. This case shall be closed on April 11, 2015.
