ORDER SETTING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING

On December 13, 2007, Kenneth Jaeger and Blue Lagoon, LLC, filed a joint application. That application requests, among other things, authority from the Commission for Mr. Jaeger to transfer his Ralls County, Missouri, lagoon and sewer system to Blue Lagoon, LLC, to grant Blue Lagoon, LLC, a certificate of convenience and necessity, and to allow Blue Lagoon, LLC, to charge certain rates to its customers.

On February 6, 2008, the Office of the Public Counsel requested a local public hearing. In a February 11 pleading, Staff stated that no parties object to OPC's request. The Commission will take up OPC's request unopposed, and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing on Saturday, March 29, 2008, at the library of the Monroe City High School, 401 Highways 24-36 East, Monroe City, Missouri.
2. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission will conduct a general information session starting at 9:30 a.m. The hearing will begin at 10:00 a.m.

3. The local public hearing will be held in facilities that meet the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Any person who needs additional accommodations to participate in these hearings should call the Public Service Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 prior to the hearing.

4. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the Ralls County Commission. In addition, the Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Ralls County, and to the members of the General Assembly representing Ralls County.

5. The applicants shall mail notice of this hearing to each customer of the sewer system, with notice mailed no later than March 16, 2008, and shall file a verified pleading in this case attesting that the applicants timely mailed the ordered notices.

6. This order shall become effective on March 10, 2008.
