GENERAL POSITION

LIST OF ISSUES

1. Does the Commission possess authority to approve ATXI's application?

Yes. The Commission stated in its Order Regarding Motion to Dismiss that the Commission is the proper authority to issue a certificate of convenience and necessity ("CCN") according to Section 393.170.1, RSMo, and that ATXI is a proper entity to receive a CCN from the Commission.

2. Does the evidence establish that the Mark Twain transmission line project, as described in ATXI's application in this docket, and for which ATXI is seeking a certificate of convenience and necessity ("CCN"), is "necessary or convenient for the public service within the meaning of that phrase in section 393.170, RSMo?

Yes. The Commission should grant ATXI a CCN, as sought in the Application in this docket.

3. Do §§ 393.170 and 229.100, RSMo., require that before the Commission can lawfully issue the requested CCN the evidence must show the Commission that where the proposed

Mark Twain transmission line project will cross public roads and highways in that county ATXI has received the consent of each county to cross them? If so, does the evidence establish that ATXI has made that showing?

No. This was already addressed by the Commission in the November Order. Pursuant to this Commission order, no evidence on this issue need be presented at the hearing.

4. If the Commission decides to grant the CCN, what conditions, if any, should the Commission impose?

On information and belief, ATXI has consented to most of the conditions recommended by the Staff. IBEW 1439 does not believe additional conditions need to be imposed.
