MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri” or “Company”), and for its Motion for Extension of Time states:

Procedural Background

1. On March 11, 2021, Charles Harter ("Complainant") filed a small formal complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") against Ameren Missouri.

2. On March 11, 2021, the Commission issued its *Order Giving Notice of Case Filing, Directing an Answer, and Directing a Staff Investigation*, which *inter alia* directed Ameren Missouri to file an answer to the Complaint no later than today, April 9, 2021.

Motion

3. Per 20 CSR 4240-2.070(15)(A), the utility against whom the small formal complaint has been filed is allowed thirty (30) days after the date of notice to “satisfy the complaint or file an answer.”

4. Per 20 CSR 4240-2.050(3), when an act is required by Commission rule or order to be done within a specified time, the Commission may order the period enlarged before the expiration of

the period originally prescribed. The period prescribed in this case will expire at 11:59 p.m. today and therefore has not yet expired.

5. The Company and Complainant are working together to resolve the Complaint to Complainant's satisfaction, but need additional time beyond the 30 days provided by the above Rule to determine if a global settlement can be reached.

6. An additional twenty-one (21) days will allow sufficient time for the Company and Complainant to communicate and determine if all of the remaining issues can be resolved.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri, with Complainant's consent, respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order extending the Company's deadline to satisfy the Complaint, or answer the Complaint, to no later than April 30, 2021.
