**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE,
AND DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A PLEADING**

On July 23, 2021, Elm Hills Utility Operating Company (Elm Hills) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system Johnson County, Missouri, as an addition to Elm Hills' existing service territories.

The requested CCN would allow the Company to provide wastewater treatment service to four residential lots adjacent to Elm Hills State Park Village service area. Elm Hills states it does not anticipate the need for external financing as it will extend its mains pursuant to its tariff provisions.

Elm Hills has also requested a waiver of the 60-day notice requirement of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1).

The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention requests. The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a recommendation on its review of Elm Hills' application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Johnson County, Missouri, and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Johnson County, Missouri, and to the news media serving Johnson County, Missouri.
3. Any person or entity wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene no later than August 24, 2021.
4. The Commission's Staff shall file a pleading indicating when it can file a recommendation no later than August 6, 2021.
5. This order is effective when issued.
