**RE: Notice – Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) – Comstock Project**

Dear [Name],

ATXI recognizes the importance of keeping stakeholders informed about projects that will affect them. You are receiving this letter because public records show that you own property along the route of a new transmission line ATXI is proposing to develop in conjunction with the Sikeston Board of Municipal Utilities, New Madrid Municipal Light & Power and the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission.

Specifically, those records indicate that you own property along the route of a new, 1.2-mile 161 kV transmission line that ATXI will construct in New Madrid County or the route of a new 161 kV transmission line extension that ATXI will construct in Scott County. Attached for your review is a map showing the route of the relevant line on your parcel(s).

We understand that ATXI or one of our project partners have already contacted you regarding the project and the associated real estate rights that will be needed. We appreciate your engagement and cooperation in helping to bring the project to fruition.

Regarding next steps, ATXI recently submitted an application to the Missouri Public Service Commission (PSC) for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity requesting authorization to construct the project. The expected timing for a PSC decision is mid-2022.

If approved by the PSC, we anticipate starting construction on your parcel(s) in September 2022. Our goal is to have this project completed and providing the intended benefits by June 2023. Those benefits including expanding reliable and cost-effective transmission pathways and working to help promote economic development.
