**ORDER GRANTING MOTION
TO EXPAND TIME TO ANSWER**

Upon a second notice of complaint issued by the Missouri Public Service Commission, Rodney Glenn Construction, Inc., RDG Development L.L.C., and Rodney Glenn, a natural person, requested additional time to file an answer. The answer was due on May 28, 2009. The request was also filed on May 28, and no party has filed a response to the motion. Respondents requested that they be allowed to file their answer on June 28¹.

Under Commission rules² the Commission, at its discretion, may enlarge the time for Respondents to file their answer. Also under Commission rules³ parties have no more than 10 days to respond to pleadings. More than 10 days have expired and no party has filed a response. The Commission will therefore grant the requested relief.
