## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO INVESTIGATE AND FILE A REPORT

Christy and Michael Scrivner filed a formal complaint against House Springs Sewer Company ("HSSC") on June 25, 2008. On June 26, 2008, the Commission notified HSSC of the complaint and allowed it thirty days in which to answer as provided by 4 CSR 240-2.070(7).

The Commission would like to have the benefit of an investigation and report by its Staff before it further considers this matter.<sup>1</sup> Given the circumstances described in the complaint, Staff should be able to complete its investigation and prepare a report concerning the results of that investigation no later than one week after HSSC files its answer, which is due no later than July 28, 2008.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall promptly commence an investigation of Christy and Michael Scrivner's formal complaint against House Springs Sewer Company.
- 2. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a report concerning the results of its investigation no later than one week after House Springs Sewer Company files its answer to Christy and Michael Scrivner's complaint.
  - 3. This order shall become effective on June 26, 2008.
