EMBARQ'S APPLICATION FOR DECLARATION OF COMPETITIVE STATUS

COMES NOW Embarq Missouri, Inc. ("Embarq"), pursuant to Section 392.245.5(7), RSMo 2008, and hereby respectfully requests the Missouri Public Service Commission to make a finding that 55 percent or more of Embarq's total subscriber access lines in Missouri are in exchanges where its services have been declared competitive by the Commission, and to deem Embarq to be a competitive company under the statute. The Commission has previously granted competitive classification to Embarq's residential services in 18 exchanges and to Embarq's business services in 50 exchanges. Embarq's subscriber access lines in these competitively classified exchanges constitute approximately 68 percent of Embarq's total subscriber access lines in Missouri, substantially more than the statutorily-prescribed 55 percent. In support of its Application for Declaration of Competitive Status, Embarq states as follows:

1. Embarq is a Missouri corporation with its principle office in Jefferson City, MO. It may be contacted at the electronic mail address, facsimile and telephone number of its attorney as set forth under Paragraph 2 below. Embarq is a "local exchange telecommunications company" and a "public utility", as those terms are defined in Section 386.020, RSMo 2000.

- 3. Embarq has no unsatisfied final judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court, which involves retail customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this application. Embarq does not have any annual report or assessment fees that are overdue.
- 4. Section 392.245.5(7) states:

Upon a finding that fifty-five percent or more of an incumbent local exchange telecommunications company's total subscriber access lines are in exchanges where such company's services have been declared competitive, the incumbent local exchange telecommunications company shall be deemed competitive and shall no longer be subject to price-cap regulation, except that rates charged for basic local telecommunications service in exchanges that were noncompetitive immediately prior to this finding can be increased to a rate that is no higher than the statewide average rate for basic local telecommunications service in the incumbent local exchange company's competitively classified exchanges for a period of four years. During the four year period, any annual increase in rates for residential basic local telecommunications service shall not exceed two dollars per line per month. Rates charged for exchange access service by an incumbent local exchange telecommunications company deemed competitive shall not exceed the rates charged at the time the company was deemed competitive.

5. Over the course of six years and nine proceedings, the Commission has previously granted Embarq competitive classification for residential services, other than exchange access

services, in 18 exchanges and for business services, other than exchange access services, in 50 exchanges, as summarized in the following chart:

- 6. Embarq intends to exercise its statutory right to be classified as competitive telecommunications company. As demonstrated in the Affidavit of John R. Idoux, Manager-Regulatory Affairs for Embarq Missouri, appended as Attachment 1 (with an HC schedule), the access lines in Embarq's exchanges that have been previously designated as competitive by the Commission constitutes 68 percent of Embarq's total subscriber access lines.
- 7. Embarq's Application does not request any price changes. Embarq acknowledges that all rates currently in effect will remain in effect until such time as Embarq files a tariff requesting a price change. Under current law, Embarq will be required to file tariffs for any future price changes, either increases or decreases, and Embarq will be required to notify its customers of any future price increase.

WHEREFORE, Embarq Missouri respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order (1) finding that 55 percent or more of Embarq Missouri's total subscriber access lines are in exchanges where its services have been declared competitive; and (2) deeming Embarq Missouri a competitive company and no longer subject to price cap regulation pursuant to Section 392.245.5(7) RSMo. (2008)

I, John R. Idoux III, of lawful age, being duly sworn, depose and state:

- My name is John R. Idoux III. I am Manager for Regulatory Affairs for Embarq Corporation. I am responsible for advocating and managing regulatory policy for Embarq Missouri, Inc.
- I have submitted this affidavit in support of Embarq's Application to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") for a finding that 55 % or more of Embarq's total subscriber access lines are in exchanges where its services have been declared competitive, and to deem Embarq to be a competitive company under Section 392.245.5(7) as amended by House Bill 1779 ("HB1779").
- I have attached to this affidavit, as Schedule 1(HC), a spreadsheet we prepared showing that 68% of Embarq's subscriber access lines are located in exchanges previously designated by the Commission as competitive for the respective service.
- 4. The summary at the top of Schedule 1 (HC) shows how I calculated that 68% of Embarq's total subscriber access lines are located in exchanges competitively classified for the respective service. It shows that I divided the total competitive access by the total number of access lines to derive the percent competitive.
- 5. Embarq has filed this Schedule as "Highly Confidential." Access line information disaggregated in this fashion and provided at this level of geographical detail is very competitively sensitive. It reveals the number of access lines a carrier serves on a very specific and localized geographic basis. Accordingly, this information falls squarely within Section A(3) of the "Highly Confidential" classification of the Commission's Standard Protective Order: "market-specific information relating to services offered in competition with others," and Section (1)(A) of the Commission's rules governing

confidential information, 4 CSR 240-2.135(1)(A). This internal market-share information has been developed at great expense and is closely guarded. If made public, this type of information would make carriers more vulnerable to the marketing efforts of their competitors. As a result, access line information at the exchange level of detail is kept confidential by carriers in the industry and is not available to the public in any format.

Schedule 1(HC) was prepared by me, using access line counts from Embarq's 2007
 Annual Report, and it is true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.
