**ORDER SCHEDULING ORAL ARGUMENT ON STAFF’S MOTION FOR
PARTIAL SUMMARY DETERMINATION**

On April 13, 2007,¹ the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed the instant complaints against Central Jefferson County Utilities, Inc. (“CJCU”), Raintree Plantation, Inc., Jeremiah Nixon, Kenneth McClain, Norville McClain, and the Norville McClain Trust. In general terms, the complaints allege that the Respondents have provided unsafe and inadequate water and sewer services to approximately 681 residents of the Raintree Plantation Subdivision in Jefferson County, Missouri.

Staff’s Motion for Partial Summary Determination in both cases under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.117(1) has been fully briefed. However, 4 CSR 240-2.117(1)(G) expressly provides that the Commission “may hear oral argument on a motion for summary

determination.” Due to the length and complexity of Staff’s motion and CJCJ’s response in opposition thereto, the Commission believes it would be helpful to hear oral argument on Staff’s motion before deciding it. Accordingly, the parties are directed to participate in an oral argument on Staff’s pending Motion for Partial Summary Determination on September 24.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The parties shall participate in an oral argument on Staff’s pending Motion for Partial Summary Determination to be held on Monday, September 24, 2007, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The argument will be conducted in Room 305 at the Commission’s offices in the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, a building that meets the accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. This order shall become effective on September 13, 2007.
