APPLICATION OF MISSOURI STATE DISCOUNT TELEPHONE FOR APPROVAL OF INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

COMES NOW, MISSOURI STATE DISCOUNT TELEPHONE and file this Application for Approval of an Interconnection Agreement (the "Agreement") between ALLTEL COMMUNICATIONS and Missouri State Discount Telephone ("MSDT"), pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("the Federal Act") and would respectfully show the Missouri Public Service Commission (the "Commission") the following:

I. INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT REACHED

MISSOURI STATE DISCOUNT TELEPHONE presents to this

Commission for approval an agreement negotiated and executed pursuant to the
terms of the Federal Act (Agreement, Attachment 1). After weeks of intensive good
faith negotiations to address all of the complex issues involved in such an agreement,
the parties have executed the Interconnection Agreement between ALLTEL
COMMUNICATIONS and MSDT on January 10, 2000, and filed herewith,
together with the four (4) appendices incorporated therein.

II. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

MISSOURI STATE DISCOUNT TELEPHONE seeks the Commission's approval of the Agreement, consistent with the provisions of the Federal Act.

MSDT believes that the implementation of this Agreement complies fully with Sections 252(e) of the Federal Act because the Agreement is consistent with the

public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. The Agreement promotes diversity in providers, provides interconnectivity, and increases customer choices for telecommunication services.

MISSOURI STATE DISCOUNT TELEPHONE respectfully request that the Commission grant expeditious approval of this Agreement, without change, suspension or other delay in its implementation. This is a bilateral agreement, reached as a result of negotiations and compromise between competitors, and the parties do not believe a docket or intervention by other parties is necessary or appropriate.

III. STANDARD FOR REVIEW

The statutory standards of review are set forth in Section 252(e) of the Federal Act which provides as follows:

Section 252(e) of the Federal Act:

(e) APPROVAL BY STATE COMMISSION

- (1) APPROVAL REQUIRED. Any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the state commission. A state commission to which an agreement is submitted to shall approve or reject the agreement, with written findings as to any deficiencies.
 - (2) GROUNDS FOR REJECTION. The State Commission may only reject -
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or

- (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
- (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity; or

IV. MISSOURI LEGISLATION

The negotiated and executed Agreement is consistent with Missouri Legislation, Senate Bill No. 507, which became effective on August 28, 1996.

V. CONCLUSION

For the reasons set forth above, MISSOURI STATE DISCOUNT TELEPHONE respectfully prays that the Commission approve the Agreement expeditiously.
