ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION

On May 24, 2016, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion requesting Friendship Village of Chesterfield's (the Company) certificate of service authority to provide shared tenant telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted the Company a certificate of service authority to provide shared tenant telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Numbers TA-97-353 and ZN-2011-0167.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
