**REPLY OF GREAT PLAINS ENERGY INCORPORATED
TO STAFF RESPONSE TO COMMISSION ORDER**

Comes now Great Plains Energy Incorporated ("GPE"), and respectfully submits this Reply to the April 19, 2002, Staff Response to Commission Order in this case.

1. As the Staff Response noted, GPE's application recited a Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") requirement, under the Public Utility Holding Company Act (the "Act"), to file quarterly reports on Form U-9C-3 with the state commissions having jurisdiction over Kansas City Power & Light Company. GPE has filed with the Commission in this case its first quarterly report for the period ended December 31, 2001. GPE filed this quarterly report with the SEC confidentially under Rule 104 of the Act; because of this, GPE's quarterly report is not shown, and future quarterly reports will not be shown, on the SEC's EDGAR system.

2. GPE is certainly willing to continue formal filings of its Form U-9C-3 reports in this case, under the Commission's protective order issued in this case. If the Commission does not wish to keep this case open, GPE will also accept, as the Staff recommends, a Commission order directing GPE to timely submit to the Director of the Utility Services Division of the Commission a copy of all future Form U-9C-3 filings made by GPE. GPE notes that Section 386.480, RSMo, would be applicable to those submissions, and is consistent with the confidential filing of Form U-9C-3 filings with the SEC.
