ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

Issue Date: November 27, 2012 Effective Date: December 7, 2012

This order cancels the private pay telephone certificate of CfL, LLC, d/b/a CfL Payphones.

On November 8, 2012, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting CfL's certificate to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri be canceled.

In Case Number TA-2000-66, the Commission granted CfL a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment.

Staff's motion states that the company requested cancellation of its certificate of service authority. CfL has sold its payphone assets and ceased business in Missouri. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel CfL's certificate of service authority.

On November 9, 2012, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than November 19, 2012. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo (Supp. 2010), which states, in part, "[a]ny

certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on CfL's request and Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the private payphone certificate granted to CfL, LLC, d/b/a CfL Payphones, shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The private payphone certificate granted to CfL, LLC, d/b/a CfL
 Payphones, in Case Number TA-2000-66, is canceled.
 - 2. This order shall become effective on December 7, 2012.
 - 3. This case may be closed on December 8, 2012.
