ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND

On June 25, 2020, the Staff of the Public Service Commission filed a pleading advising the Commission to cancel the certificate of service authority to provide private payphone services of Coyote Call, Inc., at that company's request. The Commission granted Coyote Call a certificate of service authority on January 27, 1995, in File No. TA-95-169.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's recommendation and the company's request.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Anyone wishing to respond to Staff's recommendation or request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than July 6, 2020.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
