ORDER ESTABLISHING STIPULATION DEADLINE

The Commission directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule or deadline for the filing of a stipulation no later than January 5, 1998. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a motion on January 5 asking that February 3 be established as the deadline for the filing of a stipulation. Staff stated that all the parties, with the exception of the Office of the Public Counsel, had been contacted and have agreed to the proposal. Staff pointed out that the Public Counsel has expressed an unwillingness to participate in stipulations involving competitive local exchange certificate cases, and asked the Commission to adopt the proposed deadline.

The Commission finds that it is appropriate to establish a deadline for the filing of a stipulation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Motion to Establish Deadline for Filing Stipulation and Agreement filed by the Commission Staff on January 5, 1998, is granted.
2. That the parties shall file a Stipulation and Agreement resolving the issues in this case no later than February 3, 1998.

3. That this order shall become effective on January 12, 1998.
