

Commission has full jurisdiction over its rates and services. §§ 386.250(2) and 392.200, RSMo Supp. 1997. The Commission finds that the issues in these two cases are not so similar that the outcome of TR-98-343 is dependent upon the outcome of TO-98-216. Therefore, the motion for an extension of the procedural schedule until some weeks after a Report and Order is issued in TO-98-216 will be denied. The parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than June 1, 1998.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Motion to Establish Procedural Schedule filed on April 30 is denied.
2. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than June 1, 1998.
3. That this order shall become effective on May 15, 1998.
