ORDER FURTHER SUSPENDING TARIFF SHEETS

The Commission issued an order on August 5, 1998, suspending the effective date of tariff sheets filed by VoCall Communications Corporation (VoCall) until December 8, 1998. The Commission Staff filed a Motion to Establish Procedural Schedule which the Commission granted on October 2, 1998. However, although the procedural schedule calls for a hearing on January 11, 1999, the Commission failed to further suspend the effective date of the tariff sheets. In order to accommodate the procedural schedule the Commission will suspend the effective date of the tariff sheets an additional six months, to June 8, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the effective date of the following tariff sheets submitted by VoCall Communications Corporation on July 2, 1998, is further extended to June 8, 1999, or until otherwise ordered by the Commission:
