ORDER REGARDING CASE STATUS

On January 26, 1998, the Commission issued its Order Approving Tariffs effective January 30. The Commission has not received notice of completion of the sale of the electric distribution facilities to the City of Independence, Missouri, or completion of the other transactions approved by the Commission's June 19, 1997 Order Granting Authority to Sell Certain Facilities, Modify Service Territory, and Granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. The Commission directs Kansas City Power & Light Company to file a report with the Commission advising of the status or completion of the transactions authorized.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Kansas City Power & Light Company shall file its report advising the Commission of the status or completion of the transactions authorized by the Commission's January 26 order by August 28, 1998.

2. That this order shall become effective on August 18, 1998.
