ORDER OF CORRECTION

On June 14, 1999, the Regulatory Law Judge, by delegation of authority, issued an order which incorrectly stated that the tariff of (Simply Local) had Simply Local Services, Inc. been simultaneously with its request for an extension of time to file the tariff sheets.
