ORDER DIRECTING STATUS REPORT

The Commission issued an Order Approving Transfer of Assets on November 12, 1998. In that order, LCI International Telecom Corp. (LCI), and USLD Communications, Inc. (USLD), were ordered to file notice with the Commission after the completion of the transaction authorized by the order. On July 16, 1999, LCI and USLD filed a Status Report indicating that the transaction was "expected to be completed within the next 60 to 90 days." No notice has been filed. Therefore, the Commission will direct LCI and USLD to file a report advising the Commission of the current status of the authorized transactions.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That LCI International Telecom Corp., and USLD Communications, Inc., shall file a status report with the Commission no later than February 22, 2000.

2. That this order shall become effective on February 1, 2000.
