ORDER APPROVING INTERIM BOWLING GREEN DISTRICT RATES

United Cities Gas Company (United) of Brentwood, Tennessee, submitted a tariff sheet to the Commission on February 23, 1998 carrying an effective date of April 1, 1998. The tariff sheet is designed to change Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors for its Bowling Green District due to a decrease in the spot market gas cost and the implementation of a refund. The effect of these changes will decrease United's annualized revenues by approximately \$89,500. The impact on a typical residential space heating customer using 96 Ccf of natural gas in the month of April will be a decrease of \$5.19, or 9.0%.

The Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum stating that the change in United's PGA was calculated in conformance with its approved PGA Clause and recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheet to become effective on April 1, 1998. Staff recommended that the tariff sheet submitted in this filing be approved, interim subject to refund, pending a final Commission decision in Case Nos. GR-96-197, GR-97-259 and GR-98-274.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the tariff sheet conforms to the Company's

Commission approved PGA Clause and is therefore reasonable. After considering Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff sheet should be allowed to become effective on and after the requested effective date, April 1, 1998, interim subject to refund.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheet submitted on February 23, 1998, by United Cities Gas Company of Brentwood, Tennessee, for the purpose of reflecting changes in rates for natural gas in its Bowling Green District, be, and it is, hereby approved to become effective on and after April 1, 1998, interim subject to refund. The tariff sheet approved is:
