Case No. TA-2000-260 SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc.

Subject: Staff recommendation for approval of SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc.'s application for a certificate of service authority to provide intraLATA interexchange and non-switched exchange service within the State of Missouri

On September 30, 1999, SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. (ASI), filed its <u>APPLICATION</u> (Application) for a certificate of service authority to provide intraLATA interexchange and non-switched exchange service. As an attachment to its Application, ASI filed illustrative tariffs without issued and effective dates, but did not file those tariffs, per se. On October 28, 1999, at the Telecommunications Department Staff's (Staff's) request, ASI filed a letter correcting and amending its Application's requested waivers.

In its application, ASI asked that it be granted: a Certificate of Service Authority to provide IntraLATA interexchange and non switched exchange service; a waiver of 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H), which requires a 45-day tariff effective date; a waiver of other Commission rules and statutory provisions; competitive status; and approval of its tariffs, rules and regulations as set forth its attached proposed tariffs. It also requested that it be ordered to file subsequent tariffs with the appropriate effective date prior to initially providing advanced services telecommunications within Missouri.

Staff has reviewed ASI's Application and recommends that ASI be granted a Certificate of Authority to become effective when its tariffs are filed, approved and become effective. Staff recommends that the illustrative tariffs, rules, and regulations submitted with its application not be approved until they are properly filed.
