ORDER APPROVING TARIFF AND RECOGNIZING FICTITIOUS NAMES

On July 28, 1998, Preferred Carrier Services, Inc., d/b/a Phones For All, d/b/a Telefonos Para Todos (Preferred), filed a proposed tariff and a registration of fictitious name. Although the cover letter made reference to Case No. TA-97-347, it implied that the documents were relevant to the addition of a fictitious name. The Records Department of the Commission opened a new case, Case No. TO-99-39. The tariff sheets and fictitious name information should have been filed in Case No. TA-97-347. Consequently, on September 3, 1998, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Tariff and Consolidating Cases, which consolidated Case No. TO-99-39 into Case No. TA-97-347, with Case No. TA-97-347 becoming the lead case. The Order also suspended the effective date of the tariff from August 27 to October 7, 1998.

Prior to the consolidation, on August 13, 1998, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) had filed a Staff Recommendation to approve the tariff in Case No. TO-99-39. This memorandum noted (incorrectly) that the Commission has not previously approved two d/b/a names on one tariff. A review of the Commission's recent records 3. That this Order shall become effective on October 2, 1998.
