ORDER CANCELING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Choctaw Communications, L.C., d/b/a Smoke Signal Communications (Choctaw) filed an application on June 18, 1998, requesting a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services in the State of Missouri, and requesting competitive classification. The Commission granted intervention to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) on August 4. A procedural schedule was adopted by order of the Commission entered on October 19.

On November 24, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion asking that the Commission cancel the procedural schedule because the parties had been able to resolve the outstanding issues in the case and expected to be able to file a stipulation and agreement. A Stipulation and Agreement signed by Choctaw, SWBT and Staff was filed on December 7. The filing of the Stipulation and Agreement renders the previously adopted procedural schedule unnecessary.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the procedural schedule previously adopted in this case is canceled.

2. That this order shall become effective on December 21,
