On December 6, 2006, Southern Missouri Gas Company, L.P. (SMNG or Company) d/b/a Southern Missouri Natural Gas Company of Mountain Grove, Missouri, filed an Application (Application) for a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) to provide natural gas service to the city of Lebanon, Missouri. On January 1, 2007, the Missouri Propane Gas Association (MPGA) filed an application to intervene. On February 15, 2007, the Company filed an application for a CCN to serve Houston, Licking, Lebanon, and Mountain View, Missouri. On June 13, 2007, the Staff of the Commission's Energy Department (Staff) filed its recommendation in the case, and the Company filed its Response to the Staff's recommendation. In that response, the SMNG withdrew its request to serve Mountain View. On June 29, 2007, the MPGA filed a Request for Hearing. On July 9, 2007, the parties to the case filed a Proposed Procedural schedule, which the Commission adopted on July 10.

On July 27, 2007, the Commission held a hearing in this matter. On August 13, 2007, the parties filed their initial briefs. SMNG also filed its proposed order granting applications and granting a certificate of convenience and necessity, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

On August 16, 2007, the Commission issued its Order in the case, granting SMNG a CCN to serve the areas of Houston, Licking, and Lebanon. On June 5, 2008, the Company filed proposed tariff sheets that, if approved, would update its tariff to reflect the CCN granted in this case. On June 16, 2008, the Company submitted substitute sheets correcting a page numbering problem and some redundant information. On June 16, 2008, the Company again submitted a substitute sheet to correct a map error.

The proposed tariff sheets change the map and metes and bounds description of SMNG's service territory to include the areas granted by the Commission's August 16 Order granting the CCN. Staff has reviewed the proposed tariff sheets, as substituted, recommends the Commission approve them. Staff has verified that the Company has filed its annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment. Staff has reviewed this filing and is not aware of any issue currently pending before the Commission that affects or is affected by this filing other than SMNG's financing case, Case No. GF-2007-0215.
