

## APPLICATION

Comes now William E. Evans and Loraine E. Evans, husband and wife, applicants, pursuant to Section 393.170, R.S. MO 1969, and states as follows:

- 1. Applicants are the sole owners and operators of a small water system located on Route 2, Deepwater, Missouri, 64740. That they desire to operate a public untility proposing to render water service to the public under the jurisdiction of the commission.
- 2. Communications in regards to this application should be addressed to William E. Evans, Deepwater, Missouri 64740, Route 2, or Perry M. Cortner, Attorney at Law, 300 Professional Building, 1103 Grand Avenue, Kansas City, Missouri 64106.
- 3. Applicants request permission, approval and a certificate of public convenience and necessity to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a water system for the public in an unincorporated area in Henry County, Missouri, as set forth on the map attached to the application marked Exhibit 1.
- 4. The feasibility study is attached to the application and made a part hereof as Exhibit 2.
- 5. There are no municipalities located within the proposed area; that there are no requirements of Henry County for a franchise to operate in said county.

- 6. That said water system meets all requirements of the commission and the Department of Natural Resources by having the water tested as required each month.
- 7. There are no other public utilities or governmental bodies being operated or rendered water service within the area proposed to be served.
- 8. The area requested is being developed into a subdivision by developers and plans are being made to build residential homes and other establishments within the area, all of which will need adequate water service. Therefore, a public need exists for adequate water service within the area proposed to be served and the public convenience and necessity will be promoted by the granting of the authority herein requested.

## EXHIBIT 2

YOUR APPLICANTS shows the Commission as follows:

- 1. That they have drilled two deep wells and installed pumps therein in the area known as Westhaven. Park and First Addition to Westhaven Park; that they have installed water lines from the pumps along the rear of Lots 1 through 9 and along the front of Lots 10 through 17 and the front of Lots 20, 21 and 22 in Westhaven Park at a cost of approximately Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars.
- 2. That applicants do not expect extensive construction of water mains, lines or other facilities in the immediate future due to slow development. However at a later date it is quite probable there will be need for further development.
- 3. That there will be possibility of constructing lines and connections of four or five new users in the immediate future at an estimated cost of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars.
- 4. That there are no meters to any of the users, at this time, but an estimate of the water used by the different users per month are as follows:

that the proposed rates would be to Parker \$9.00 per month, to Hewitt \$6.00 per month, to Long \$6.00 per month, to Chisam \$6.00 per month, to Cortner \$6.00 per month (for summer months) and Wilson is an invalid and has not used his cabin for three years, until meters can be installed.

5. That the total income from the existing facilities

are \$36.00 per month, at the proposed rates.

- 6. That no connection fees have been charged todate, but the proposed connection fees are One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.
- 7. These applicants have no way of knowing or estimating future income for the next three years for water sales or for connection fees except as herein above set out.
- 8. That the operating expenses, not including replacement for existing facilities for the past three years averaged \$20.17 per month, or \$242.00 per year for well number one, plus replacing pump at \$626.13 for each well; that insurance rates have now increased.
- 9. That the estimate for operating expenses for the next three years is Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars per year.
- 10. That the system is wholly owned by applicants and no plan of financing is expected.
- 11. These applicants feel that they are financially able to continue the utility service during the development years as theirs is a small development; that the applicants owned the land in the area and have heretofore subdivided it with lots left for sale.
