APPLICATION FOR INTEREXCHANGE AUTHORITY AND COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION

Comes now NOW Communications, Inc. ("Applicant" or "NCI"), by and through counsel, and pursuant to Sections 392.361, 392.420, 392.440 RSMo 1994, Section 392.410 RSMo Supp. 1997, and 4 CSR 240-2.060(4), files this Verified Application requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission (hereinafter "the Commission") issue an order that:

- (a) grants Applicant a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate resold, interexchange telecommunications services, as herein more specifically defined, pursuant to Chapter 392 RSMo;
- (b) grants competitive status to Applicant and Applicant's requested services; and
- (c) waives certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to Sections 392.420 and 392.361 RSMo 1994, consistent with the Commission's past treatment of other certificated providers of competitive telecommunications services.

In support of its request, Applicant states that:

1. Applicant is a corporation formed and operating under the laws of the State of Mississippi and is duly authorized to transact business in the State of Missouri. Pursuant to the relevant provisions of 4 CSR 240-2.060, documents from the Missouri Secretary of State's Office are attached hereto and incorporated herein as Appendix A. 3. By this Application, Applicant proposes to provide various types of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services throughout the state of Missouri on a resold, prepaid basis. At this time Applicant is not seeking authority to provide non-switched, dedicated private line services. Specifically, Applicant seeks authority to provide prepaid MTS and other similar interexchange services pursuant to resale arrangements with underlying interexchange carriers. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H), Applicant's proposed tariff bearing a forty-five (45) day effective date is attached hereto and incorporated herein as

Appendix B. Applicant has based its proposed tariff on tariffs for which it has received approval in other jurisdictions. Applicant recognizes that the staff may require certain Missouri-specific format and perhaps content changes to Applicant's proposed tariff and will work with the staff to make such changes, as needed, through substitute tariff sheet filings.

- 4. Applicant requests that it and all its services proposed herein be classified as competitive. Applicant's proposed services herein fall within the category of the types of services which have routinely been authorized by the Commission for numerous other competitive carriers upon verified application without the need for evidentiary hearings. Applicant's proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation; granting this Application will allow greater price and service options for telecommunications customers and will be in the public interest. Granting Applicant's requested competitive classifications is consistent with past Commission treatment of other competitive certificated interexchange carriers and will encourage competition consistent with the public policy of Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo.
- 5. Applicant is willing to comply with all applicable Commission orders, rules and regulations. Applicant requests however, pursuant to Section 392.440 RSMo 1994, that the Commission at minimum waive the application of the following rules and statutory provisions as they relate to the regulation of Applicant to the extent that they previously and routinely have been waived for other certificated competitive interexchange carriers:

6. Applicant is financially capable of providing the services proposed. Applicant also possesses the necessary technical and managerial expertise and experience necessary to provide the services it proposes to offer at standards that will meet or exceed all service standards established by the Commission. While not required under the rules to be filed for purposes of an interexchange certificate application, additional information regarding Applicant's financial qualifications and managerial expertise have been provided to the Commission in Applicant's currently pending CLEC Application in Case No. TA-98-390. Applicant currently is providing prepaid basic local and/or prepaid interexchange services in the following states: Alabama, Colorado, Kansas, Louisiana, Mississippi and Tennessee. In addition to Missouri, Applicant has applications pending in Florida, Georgia, Oklahoma and Texas.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission: 1) expeditiously grant it a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate, resold interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Missouri; 2) grant Applicant and its proposed services competitive status; and 3) waive the application of the above-referenced statutes and Commission rules; all consistent with past Commission practice and the Commission's treatment of other certificated, competitive providers of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services.
