APPLICATION

COMES NOW SPOKANE HIGHLANDS WATER COMPANY, a Missouri Corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Applicant" and respectfully states:

1. That the Applicant is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri, and has its principal offices and place of business at Spokane, Missouri. A copy of its Certificate of Incorporation and Articles of Incorporation are hereto attached and marked Exhibit A and Exhibit B respectively, and incorporated herein.

2. Communications in regard to the Applicant should be addressed to Kirk R. Jones, President, Spokane Highlands Water Company, 1250 Jonesville Road, Spokane, Missouri 65754, and David N. Appleby, Attorney at Law, 119 North Second Street, P.O. Box 158, Ozark, Missouri, 65721.

3. Applicant seeks a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to build, construct, operate and maintain a water system and all other facilities, including the acquisition of

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MISSOURI PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION easements, rights of way, land, etc., necessary for the purpose of furnishing water service to the public in a service area to include all of the area described in Exhibit C attached hereto.

4. Applicant states that there are no water companies under jurisdiction of the commission being operated or rendering service within the area proposed to be served.

5. Applicant states that the area proposed to be served is rapidly being developed into a residential subdivision and that there are seventy-four homes being planned in the near future within said area, all of which will need adequate water.

6. The Applicant will not require additional financing to construct said water system; however, all assets of the Corporation, to include the water system, are subject to a lien at Ozark Bank, Ozark, Missouri.

7. Applicant states that there is and will be a public need for water service within the area proposed to be served and that public convenience and necessity will be promoted by the granting of the authority herein requested.

8. There is a no municipality located within the proposed area, and the County of Christian has no ordinances that apply, and specifically no ordinances requiring a franchise for water companies.

9. There are presently eight residents (including the undersigned Kirk R. Jones), with two more anticipated in the next sixty days, in the proposed service area. Names and addresses are as follows:

4. To exercise all of the powers conferred upon it as a corporation as set forth in Section 351.385 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, each of which powers is hereby incorporated by reference and is stated to be one of the purposes for which this corporation is formed.

Notice of the proposed transfer shall be given to the corporation, and the notice shall include the number of shares proposed to be transferred, the consideration to be paid, and the name of the prospective transferee. If the corporation has not exercised this option prior to the expiration of such time, the stockholder shall be free to transfer, alienate, or otherwise dispose of such stock without any restriction.

Feasibility Letter

SPONANE HIGHLANDS is a subdivision at Spokane, Christian County, Missouri now being developed. There are 74 lots being developed which comprise the service area. A copy of the plat indicating said lots is attached to the application as Exhibit C. Developer still owns approximately 64 lots in the service area (eight have sold and two are under contract for sale).

A deep water well and pressure tank, which will service all 74 lots, and distribution lines in the service area, are under construction. DNR approval awaits granting of the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. Construction costs for the well and tank are estimated to be \$54,038.00. No additional financing is required; however all assets of the SPOKANE HIGHLANDS WATER COMPANY are subject to a lien at Ozark Bank, Ozark, Missouri.
