STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) by and through one of its attorneys, and for its Recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) grant Teligent Services, Inc. (Company) a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services and a certificate to provide local exchange telecommunications services restricted to dedicated private line services. Under current law, the Commission can grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is "in the public interest". (See §§ 392.430 and 392.440, RSMo 1994.)
- 2. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the Company and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser

degree of regulation. (See §392.361.2 RSMo 1994.) All the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. (See §392.361.3 RSMo 1994.)

- 3. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Application with the exception of the request to waive 4 CSR 240-32.030(4)(A)(2) due to the fact that this rule does not apply to interexchange carriers. The Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain statutes if the Commission determines that waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392 RSMo. (See §§ 392.361.3 and 392.420 RSMo 1994 and §392.185 RSMo Supp 1999.)
- 4. Staff lastly recommends that the Commission approve the applicant's proposed tariff, PSC MO NO. 1, with a proposed effective date of 5/31/2000.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission grant the Company a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services and a certificate to provide local exchange telecommunications services restricted to dedicated, private line service, grant the Company and its services a competitive classification, approve the Company's proposed tariff, PSC MO NO. 1 with a proposed effective date of May 31, 2000, and approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Application with the exception of the waiver requested in connection with 4 CSR 240-32.030(4)(A)(2).
