Recommendation to Approve Basic Local Telecommunications Services Subject: P.S.C. MO. Tariff No. 1 of Snappy Phone of Texas, Inc.

On April 28, 2000, The Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an order granting Snappy Phone of Texas, Inc. (Snappy), a Certificate of Authority to provide basic local and interexchange telecommunications services and to classify the company and its services as competitive. At that time, the Commission also ordered the Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) to file its Recommendation regarding the proposed tariff at least seven (7) working days prior to the effective date of the proposed tariff. On May 21, 2000, the Commission issued an Order Approving Interconnection Agreement by and between Snappy and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) and Pacific Bell. On April 18, 2000, Snappy submitted an original proposed Basic Local Telecommunications Tariff to the Commission. On May 19, 2000, Snappy withdrew the proposed tariff due to errors and omissions. On May 23, 2000, Snappy refiled a corrected proposed tariff. On June 20, Snappy, pursuant to Staff's request, submitted substitute pages for every page of the proposed tariff, pages 1-30, to correct for further errors and omissions.

Staff has reviewed Snappy's proposed basic local and interexchange telecommunications services tariff and finds that it conforms to the Commission's April 28, 2000 order in the current case. Snappy has received authority to provide prepaid resold service only in SWBT exchanges. The proposed tariff includes the list of waivers approved in the Commission's Order Granting Snappy's Certificate of Authority. Snappy's proposed tariff is and rates are similar to those of other Competitive Local Exchange Carriers providing prepaid resold services to residential customers.

Staff has no objections to Snappy's proposed tariff taking effect and recommends that the Commission issue an Order Approving Tariff. Snappy's proposed P.S.C. Mo. No. 1 Tariff contains the following sheets to become effective July 7, 2000: Original sheet No. 1-Original Sheet No. 30. Staff is unaware of any other filing which affects or would be affected by this filing.
