APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

COMES NOW IP Communications Corporation (IP), and files its Application for Approval of Interconnection Agreement (Agreement) between IP and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) under the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Federal Act). In support of that Application, IP states as follows:

I. INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT REACHED

IP presents to this Commission for approval an Interconnection Agreement negotiated and executed pursuant to the terms of the Federal Act. A copy of the Agreement is provided as Attachment I. After extensive negotiations between SWBT and IP, the Agreement was executed by IP on February 6, 2000, and by SWBT on February 14, 2000. The Agreement consists of 677 pages, including exhibits and appendices. The pages have been numbered in the bottom right corner, seriatim, so there will be no need for the Commission to order a page-numbered copy to be filed after approval. There are no outstanding issues between IP and SWBT that need the assistance of mediation or arbitration.



II. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

IP seeks the Commission's approval of the Agreement, consistent with the provisions of the Federal Act and Missouri law. The implementation of this Agreement complies fully with Section 252(3) of the Federal Act because the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier.

IP respectfully requests that the Commission grant expeditious approval of this Agreement, without change, suspension or other delay in its implementation. This is a bilateral agreement, reached as a result of negotiations and compromise between the parties.

III. STANDARD FOR REVIEW

The statutory standards of review are set forth in Section 252(e) of the Federal Act which provides as follows:

- (e) Approval by State Commission
 - (1) Approval required.--Any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State commission. A State commission to which an agreement is submitted shall approve or reject the agreement, with written findings as to any deficiencies.
 - (2) Grounds for rejection.--The state commission may only reject--
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) if it finds that--
 - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
 - the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

IV. MISSOURI LAW

The negotiated and executed Agreement is consistent with Missouri Law.

V. CONCLUSION

For the reasons set forth above, IP respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Agreement expeditiously.
