SECOND ORDER REGARDING CASE STATUS

The order directed that such report was to be filed by October 23. North American Telephone Network, Inc., f/k/a North American Telephone Network, L.L.C. has failed to file such report.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That North American Telephone Network, Inc., f/k/a North American Telephone Network, L.L.C., shall, no later than January 7, 1999,

file its report advising the Commission of the status or completion of the transactions authorized by the Commission's May 28 order.

- 2. That North American Telephone Network, Inc., f/k/a North American Telephone Network, L.L.C., is advised that failure to comply with an order of the Commission may subject it to the penalties set forth at Sections 386.570 and 386.580, RSMo (1994).
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on December 29, 1998.
