ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF CORPORATE NAME
AND APPROVING ADOPTION NOTICE

International Charity Network, Inc., a Delaware corporation, submitted an adoption notice on April 1, 1998, and an amended adoption notice on April 7 designed to reflect its change of corporate name to "Charities Network International, Inc." (CNI). The company was certificated to provide interexchange telecommunications services on July 30, 1997, in Case No. TA-97-518. CNI included with its filing an Amended Certificate of Authority from the Missouri Secretary of State reflecting its new corporate name. The adoption notice carries an effective date of May 1, 1998.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum on April 22 stating that it had reviewed the company's filings and adoption notice and had no objection to their approval. Staff recommended that the name change be recognized and the adoption notice approved to become effective on May 1.

The Commission has reviewed CNI's filing, the adoption notice, the amended adoption notice, and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the change of name should be recognized. The Commission further finds that the

adoption notice reflecting that change of name should be approved as amended.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the change of corporate name from "International Charity Network, Inc." to "Charities Network International, Inc." is acknowledged.

2. That the amended adoption notice denominated P.S.C. Mo. - No. 1, Original Adoption Notice Page is approved to become effective on May 1, 1998.

3. That this order shall become effective on May 1, 1998.
