ORDER ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

MiComm Services, Inc. (MiComm) filed an application for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services on August 28, 1997. MiComm filed an Amended Application on November 4.

Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) filed an application to intervene which was granted on October 14, and the parties were directed to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than November 7. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a Motion to Establish Procedural Schedule on November 7. Staff stated that it no longer opposes MiComm's application because the Amended Application indicates that MiComm does not wish to offer services on a prepaid basis. Staff stated that all the parties are agreed that a Stipulation and Agreement can be filed by November 21, and asked the Commission to approve this date as the procedural schedule for the case.

The Commission has considered Staff's motion and will adopt the proposed procedural schedule. The parties shall file a stipulation no later than November 21 or, if no agreement can be reached, a proposed procedural schedule with dates for the filing of testimony.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the parties shall file a Stipulation and Agreement or, if no agreement can be reached, a proposed procedural schedule no later than November 21, 1997.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on November 18, 1997.
