## ORDER DENYING APPLICATIONS FOR REHEARING

On July 1, 2015, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued a Report and Order effective July 31, 2015, regarding Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC's application for a certificate of convenience and necessity. On July 29, 2015, Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC and the Missouri Landowners Alliance filed applications for rehearing. Show Me Concerned Landowners and United for Missouri, Inc. filed responses to the Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC application for rehearing on August 7, 2015.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2000, states that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." In the judgment of the Commission, neither Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC nor the Missouri Landowners Alliance has shown sufficient reason to rehear the matter. The Commission will deny the applications for rehearing.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC's Application for Rehearing is denied.
