ORDER AND NOTICE

On March 9, 1998, MoKan Dial, Inc. and Choctaw Telephone Company filed an application to determine certain aspects of the continued provisioning of Metropolitan Calling Area (MCA) Service.

The application states that it is filed pursuant to the following authorities: Sections 392.240 and 392.250 RSMo, the statutes under which authority the Commission established MCA service; the terms of the MCA order in Case No. TO-92-306, recognizing the potential for rate changes in the future; Sections 392.200 and 392.230 RSMo, the statutes under which the Commission regulates service and rates; the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, especially 47 USC 251(b)(3) and 253, the statutes covering interconnection and removal of barriers to entry; and the general regulatory authority of the Commission, which is authorized to entertain issues regarding the continued provisioning of a Commission-created service.

Proper parties should be given notice and an opportunity to intervene. The Records Department shall send a copy of this order to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.


