## ORDER APPROVING INTEREXCHANGE AND NONSWITCHED LOCAL EXCHANGE CERTIFICATES OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Comcast Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a/ Comcast Long Distance (Comcast) applied to the Public Service Commission on May 13, 1998, for certificates of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Section 392.410-.450, RSMo 1994 and RSMo Supp. 1997<sup>1</sup>. Comcast asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and waive certain statutes and rules as authorized by Sections 392.361 and 392.420. Comcast is a Pennsylvania corporation, with its principal office located at 211 South Gulph Road, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania 19406.

The Commission issued a Notice of Applications and Opportunity to Intervene on May 26, directing parties wishing to intervene to file their requests by June 10. The requirement for a hearing is met when the opportunity for hearing has been provided and no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence. State ex rel.
