## **ORDER SETTING HEARING**

An early prehearing conference was held on September 16, 1997 in this case. The Commission has determined that a hearing is needed to enable the Commission to decide whether to approve the tariff filed by the applicant on July 25, 1997. The parties should come prepared to address, by sworn testimony, Commission questions on the issue of whether the tariff submitted by applicant complies with the Revised Statutes of Missouri and the Commission's regulations.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Commission will conduct a hearing on Thursday, October 9, 1997, at 9:00 a.m. in Room 520B, Harry S Truman State Office Building, 301 West High Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.
- 2. That the parties may present an order of witness presentation no later than September 23, 1997.
- 3.
