SUBMISSION OF ASSET PURCHASE AGREEMENT

Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) states the following:

1. Paragraph 14 of the Stipulation and Agreement approved by the Commission in its August 13, 2013 Report and Order regarding these proceedings requires KCP&L to file a copy of the final purchase agreement whereby certain electric transmission property is transferred from KCP&L and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Co. (“GMO”) to Transource Missouri, LLC (“Transource Missouri”). Paragraph 14 also calls for KCP&L to provide details of the costs included in construction work in progress (“CWIP”) and of the property to be transferred. See Exhibit A (Highly Confidential).

2. In compliance with those provisions, KCP&L hereby provides a copy of the Asset Purchase Agreement (“Agreement”) by and between KCP&L, GMO and Great Plains Energy Services Incorporated, as the Sellers, and Transource Missouri, as the Purchaser, with an effective date of January 2, 2014. Because certain terms and conditions of the Agreement contain proprietary and highly confidential information with regard to the structure of the transactions described, it is attached in a confidential format, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.135. See Exhibit B (Highly Confidential).

3. With regard to the Supplemental Filing that Transource Missouri, KCP&L and GMO made on December 31, KCP&L states that the control budget estimates that were provided in Paragraph 2 as “highly confidential” figures are no longer confidential. Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (“SPP”) issued its “First Quarterly Project Tracking Report 2014” on January 7, 2014, which contains estimates related to the Sibley-Nebraska City Project, as well as other projects. The base estimate of the project continues to be \$404,000,000. When the project’s AFUDC (allowance for funds used during construction) of \$3,764,364 is added to the base estimate, the first quarter 2014 cost estimate, as reported by SPP, is \$407,764,364. See Exhibit C.

WHEREFORE, Kansas City Power & Light Company supplements the record in this regard.
